



VATSIM is a world wide virtual community. The main positions (e.g. the Founders, the Board of Governors and the Executive Committee) are working internationally, currently staffed with members from across the globe.

Of course, members around the world have local groups which lead the local training, the community, and give you the local contact to hobbyists with the same hobby. Therefore, VATSIM is currently organized in six regions, which cover our virtual world. Each region is divided into different smaller organizations, called Divisions. And Divisions may hold the local member organizations such as vACCs, FIRs, or ARTCCs.

Africa & Middle East

Region Director: Thomas Mathieu

VATSIM Africa & Middle East Region (VATAME) is responsible for counties of the African continuent and Middle East including the Persian Gulf.

Asia

Region Director: Anastasios Stefopoulos

VATSIM Asia Region (VATASIA) is responsible for countries for the majority of Asia, stretching from Pakistan to Japan, though not including Russia.

Europe

Region Director: Apostolos Damkalis

VATSIM Europe Region (VATEUR) is comprised of continental Europe, the United Kingdom, Ireland, the Balkans, Scandinavia, Turkey, the Mediterranean islands and Russian-speaking countries.

North America

Region Director: Nicola Felini

VATSIM North America Region (VATNA) is comprised of the USA, Canada, Mexico and Central America

Oceania

Region Director: Jackson Harding

VATSIM Oceania Region (VATOCE) administers a large geographical area in the South Pacific which includes Australia, New Zealand and all the island nations in the South Pacific, including many parts of Antarctica.

South America

Region Director: Federico Navarro


VATSIM South America Region (VATSA) administers the entire South American continent plus Central America.











WHO WE ARE

Home / Who we are

The International Virtual Aviation Organisation, IVAO for short, was founded in 1998 to provide an online platform for flight simulation enthusiasts to enjoy their hobby in a simulated real-world environment, in company of other people, flying or providing Air Traffic Control services.

IVAO is a legally registered not-for-profit-organisation (NPO) under Belgian law. It has a multi-layered management structure to ensure it is strategically governed in a fair, legal and transparent way. All IVAO's services and software will always be provided free of charge as the organisation's costs are covered by private donations and corporate sponsorship. MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE



BOARD OF GOVERNORS

The Board of Governors (BoG) are legally responsible for the NPO. The Board is led by the President and is responsible for setting the overall goals of the network, managing financial and legal matters, and appointing the Executive Committee.

The Board consists of 9 Governors, who are elected by the General Assembly for a renewable two-year term. The board is chaired by the President of IVAO.



EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

The Executive Council is responsible for the global oversight and management of the IVAO Departments and Divisions. It is also the highest governing body for all Network matters such as suspensions, staff appointments and project management.

The Executive Council consists of 4-5 members who are appointed by the Board of Governors for a renewable two-year term.



DEPARTMENTS

IVAO has several departments, headed on a global level by a Director appointed by the Executive Council who is assisted by Advisors, or specialised staff.


Departments manage all tasks that affect the network globally such as training standards, central databases, network infrastructure and software. Some departments also cover areas for where there is no local division established.



DIVISIONS

Divisions are managed by a Director appointed by the Executive Council. The Division director is usually local to the country or region.

Divisions provide localised information for members and are the first point of contact for most matters. Divisions are responsible for publishing documentation, procedures and charts for their area of responsibility as well as organising events and tours and providing training.
